SYNC YOUR CALENDAR TO THE BAND CALENDAR

There are instructions on the band calendar page to do so. You may have to alter the steps for your personal calendar. I did it for my iOS device. Sync for WHS Band (and color guard, if applicable, for your student). Here's the link to the band calendar page:

BAND REGISTRATION

In late May or early June, you will receive an email to register for band. Through the registration process you will select your payment plan, indicate your areas of interest for volunteering, and select a few things to buy. Selecting an area of interest for volunteering does not obligate you to anything. The person in charge of the area you selected will get in touch with you based on your indication of interest when they are ready to start signing up for that job. Check off as many areas as you like! Students will be required to have two t-shirts- a show shirt and a rehearsal shirt. (I recommend choosing two of each of these shirts.) Show shirts and rehearsal shirts are worn under the marching uniform, and the band directors will tell students which shirt to wear each time they perform. Parents may also order a show shirt. Show shirts (or other Westwood

band shirts) are great for wearing to concession stand shifts or marching competitions. Photo buttons are also for sale on the registration form. Photo buttons have a photo of your student in their uniform. By their senior year, you can collect all four! It is fun to wear your photo buttons to games and performances, and they are a great keepsake. I buy two- one for each parent.

SPORTS PHYSICALS

Band students are required to submit a sports physical prior to the beginning of band camp. Your primary care doctor can do that, but walk-in urgent care places can also do it. At 620 and Anderson Mill, [CareNow Urgent Care](#) is open 7 days a week and can do them on a walk-in basis. The band directors will send out a form over the summer, but if you have an appointment sooner, you can find the form online. Here is a current link to the [UIL page for marching band requirements](#).

BAND NOTES

Every week the band directors email “Band Notes” to all band families, typically on Sunday afternoons. Band Notes give the schedule of events for the next two weeks plus any details needed. Take the time to review the Band Notes carefully. They can often answer any questions you have about the week’s performances or competitions such as what to wear, what they need to bring, where and when they are meeting, whether or not a meal is provided, whether or not they need to bring money, what time they will return, etc. It is a very helpful document.

IS COLOR GUARD PART OF BAND?

Color guard performs with the band in the fall semester during football and marching season. When the *band camp* and *fall schedules* say “Full Band,” color guard is expected to be there. (Color guard does rehearse once a week on their own during football season, as well.) In the spring, the band and color guard are separate. The band splits into 4 ensembles and has their concert season while color guard has their own winter guard season with indoor competitions throughout the spring semester.

WHAT IS BOA?

BOA stands for Bands of America. Take a look at the [BOA website](#) to see what it is all about! BOA days are marching band competitions and take up the whole day for the students. Be prepared! The end of September, October, and the first weekend of November are full of competitions that are full day events! Also, it’s great to have a BIG cheering section at all competitions. Come and cheer on the band!! Performance times will be announced ahead of time. You do not have to be there all day!

The Westwood Band website has a good guide to the [scoring in the competitions](#). Take a look and see what the judges are looking for.

WHAT IS UIL?

UIL stands for University Interscholastic League and involves Texas athletics and music programs and competitions. The rules we follow (such as rehearsal time allowances, the now-required

physicals for the students, and the rules for the time length and content of the show) are put in place by UIL and are statewide. The Westwood Band will participate in UIL marching contest in the fall and concert/sightreading contest in the spring. More information about UIL is found [here](#).

What is DCI?

DCI stands for Drum Corps International. Students age 14-21 audition to spend their summers marching in a drum and bugle corps made up of percussion, brass, and color guard. There are drum corps from all over the country. These corps learn and rehearse a show, then travel to DCI shows all over the United States competing. At the end of the summer, there is a final show where all drum corps compete. Westwood has had a number of students participate in drum corps. A few are marching this summer, as well. Check out the [DCI website](#) for more information!

On August 4th, the Westwood Band will host a DCI Austin show at Kelly Reeves Athletic Complex (10211 W. Parmer Lane, Austin, 78717). We will need volunteers, but it is a great chance for you to see what DCI is all about, too.

GAME AND COMPETITION TICKETS

You can buy **football game tickets** at the gate, or your student can buy the tickets for you ahead of time at a slightly reduced price at school. You may also be able to buy online through RRISD. Try [here](#) if you want to buy football tickets online. If the previous link does not work, go to the [Westwood Website](#) and go to the A-Z Index. There is a heading for football tickets. Click on that, and you should be able to get tickets online.

Tickets for **marching competitions** can be bought at the gate and sometimes online. The [Round Rock ISD online store](#) is a good place to begin looking for tickets to band competitions and Festival of Bands (an exhibition put on by all RRISD marching bands). Students want their parents and families there to cheer on the band. Plan to go to as many performances as you can. You will love seeing how the show progresses and improves with each performance!

If you subscribe to [Flomarching.com](#), you can live stream BOA marching competitions that you are unable to attend. There is a subscription fee of \$29.99/month if you choose to pay monthly, and you can cancel at any time. You may also choose to pay for a full year's subscription in one payment of \$150 (which averages out to \$12.50/month).

Also, check the [FAQs](#) on the band website. There is lots of useful information there!

The following is the marching season schedule all in one place with notes about events that are not self-explanatory.

BAND CAMP

The times vary from day to day. Students need a lunch, snacks, and water (a [half gallon jug](#) is recommended) every day. Good, sturdy tennis shoes, such as good cross trainers or running

shoes, should be worn. Bring hats, sunglasses, and plenty of sunscreen, too. Parents trade off on providing snack for their student's section after rehearsals on certain days. Sign ups will be sent out by your section parent. Snacks are given out in the parking lot by the band hall after rehearsals. Parents have a sign for their section (something simple on a poster board with the name of the section) and serve the snack from their trunk or a table by their car! Students will come find their section- you just have to be there ready for them!

SNACKS!

Either the week before or the first week of band camp, you will receive an email from your section parent asking you to sign up to bring snack for your section after rehearsal. We bring snacks most days during band camp and twice a week once school starts. Snacktime is the time for the kids to have fun and socialize after a rigorous rehearsal. Snacks after rehearsal are served in the parking lot by the bandhall. Park your car in a spot about 15 minutes before the end of rehearsal. It is best to park in a place that does not back up to the carline drive. You will see other parents doing the same thing you are, so you can watch them for guidance! Snacks can be distributed from the back of your car, or you can bring a table and set it up on that. The kids love individually wrapped chips, cookies, granola bars, popsicles, ice cream sandwiches, etc. Also, feel free to bring cold water bottles or a sports drink. The band directors have asked that we not bring meal-type snacks like pizza or burgers so that other sections are not left out. Bring a simple sign with your section name on it, and wait. They will come! During the school year, we bring one snack for after school rehearsals and one on game day after the early morning rehearsal. The snack after the game day early morning rehearsal is usually something like breakfast tacos. They have time to refuel, talk, and prepare for the school day.

BAND CAMP SCHEDULE NOTES

The start times listed are the times that rehearsal *begins*. If students show up right at the start time, they are late getting started. Plan to get them there 15 minutes early so they are ready to go at start time. As they say in the Westwood Band, "If you're early, you're on time. If you're on time, you're late!"

Section Colors: During band camp, there are times that each band section wears its signature color- at practice and for social events (such as **Band Olympics). Your student will want to have a shirt in their color:

Altos: Orange

Baritones: White

Color Guard: Tie Dye or rainbow

Clarinets: Gray

Flutes: Blue

Low Reeds: Green

Mellos: Purple

Percussion: Black

Trombones: Light blue

Trumpets: Red

Tubas: Pink

**Band Olympics is a social event (for students only) after band camp. The sections come together and compete in fun (and sometimes silly) games- great team building and bonding time. The social events allow the kids time to talk, have fun, and get to know each other better.

**If a football game is on Thursday, we follow a Game Day schedule with a rehearsal at 7:30am and the game after school. On weeks with a Thursday game, we typically have rehearsal from 4:45-6:45 pm on Friday. (This year we have two Thursday games on September 9th and 16th.)

Game Days:

On game days, students are expected to come at **7:15am** for a before-school rehearsal (rehearsal starts at 7:30, but they're late if they show up right at 7:30!). They stay after school, have dinner, and ride busses to the game. Dinner is served to them by Game Day volunteers, so your student's dinner is covered. Students get back on the busses and return to Westwood after the game. They will most likely arrive around 10:30-11:00-ish. You will be notified when they are on their way back to Westwood so you can be there to pick them up. If you get to the school before the busses do, park in the parking lot or on the street. The busses will pull into the drive next to the band hall and unload there. For parents who are not with the band as chaperones for the game, please do buy tickets and come to the game! Your students want you there to cheer them on! The band parents typically sit near the band block, so you can always find someone to sit with. It is a great way to meet other parents and get involved with our band family!

****There will be exceptions to this schedule, so pay close attention to Band Notes for exceptions and changes that come up!** Example: We have two Thursday night games this year (9/9 and 9/16). The schedule for Thursday night games is the same as Friday games. Most of the time when there is a Thursday game, there will be a Friday rehearsal.

Band uniform cleaning: You are not responsible for cleaning the band uniforms. The band periodically sends them out to the cleaners. Color guard uniforms are different, however. If you need to clean guard uniforms, cleaning instructions will be sent out by the color guard director or a guard parent.

Starting August 23rd, the band will fall into their regular school rehearsal schedule.

****Game Day AND BOA San Antonio on the same day**: Students will go on busses to San Antonio if they have a playtime on Friday (which they typically do). The time they leave for San Antonio depends on their performance time. They will miss some classes. They will return to Austin in the evening but will go back the following day. *If it is possible to be back in time for the football game after they play in San Antonio, they will go to the game upon their return to Austin. If their San Antonio performance time is too late in the day, they will miss the football game. This year, they will miss the football game since they are in the last block of performers for the day.*

11/6: BOA San Antonio Day 2: Students will arrive Saturday morning, get on busses to go back to San Antonio, watch other bands perform, and wait for the announcement as to whether or not they advance to finals. If they make finals, they will stay and perform again. If they do not make finals, they will come home. Arrival time back to Westwood depends on whether or not they perform in finals. It could be as early as 9 pm but could also be much later if they perform and stay until the end of the competition.
